The jewel of the Louis Roederer House is Cristal, created in 1876 for Tsar
Alexander II. This is champagne at its finest, the embodiment of elegance &
purity. An intense nose of white flowers, citrus & red berries, followed by
warmer hints of toast & wood. On the palate, ripe lush fruits & toasty flavours.
A dense, fleshy structure with a powerful finish.
